

# CENTRAL VICTORIA SOLAR CITY – ECO HOLIDAY TERMS AND CONDITIONS



*Local energy solutions.*

- 1.** The promoter is Sustainable Regional Australia Pty Ltd, 3 Johnstone Street Castlemaine VIC, 3450, ACN 114 664 050 (**Promoter**).
- 2.** Information on “how to enter” form part of conditions of entry. Participation in this competition constitutes acceptance of these conditions of entry.
- 3.** Entry is open to all residents of Australia who fulfil the entry requirements set out within these conditions, except directors, management, and employees of the promoter (and their immediate families), associated companies, and retailers, suppliers and agencies of the Promoter.
- 4.** The competition commences on 21 November 2009 at 9am and closes on 30 June 2013 at 5pm (Australian Eastern Standard time).
- 5.** Valid entries can only be made by a representative from a household located in one of the Central Victorian Solar City’s 14 municipalities, in the following manner:
  - 5.1.** Completing and signing a Participation Agreement relating to the Central Victoria Solar City’s research trial project;
  - 5.2.** Completing a “Home Energy Assessment” as part of that research trial in accordance with the conditions of assessment provided in the Central Victoria Solar City’s Home Energy Assessment Booklet;
  - 5.3.** Providing personal details to the relevant Assessor to enable the Assessor to complete an entry form for the competition on behalf of the household;
  - 5.4.** The Assessor will then provide the completed entry form to Sustainable Regional Australia Pty Ltd by way of entry into the competition.
  - 5.5.** The household continues to take part in research until the end of the research trial, estimated to be completed in mid-2013.
- 6.** Only one entry is permitted per household located within the Central Victorian Solar City’s 14 municipalities.
- 7.** The Promoter takes no responsibility for late, lost, misdirected or illegible/inaudible entries.
- 8.** The winner will be the first valid entry randomly drawn from the entries at the premises of Sustainable Regional Australia, at 3 Johnstone Street Castlemaine VIC 3450 on 24 July 2013 at 11am.
- 9.** If an entry is deemed not to comply with these conditions, the entry will be discarded and a new winner of that prize will be determined by drawing a further valid entry.
